About The Council

The 21st Century Council (the Council) is a program of the Congressional Black Caucus Institute. The mission of the Council is to identify, explore and research major policy issues affecting the nation. PROGRAM: The Council meets quarterly with an annual meeting held in South Carolina in the first quarter of each year.
